

About my work

My pictures show found and created situations, some of which have been digitally enhanced. I look for the transcendent in the seemingly banal, or rather I use my pictures to open up access to a world that lies beyond the tangible. Elements of everyday life, reflections, portraits and self-made objects are sometimes synthesised with other layers of images. My works build on each other and are organically connected. Individual motifs appear again and again in a modified form. In my work, I deal with existential themes. I am interested in aspects of our humanity that are often suppressed. The fear of death, our own vulnerability, fragility, the view into the "unredeemed" past. Linked to this is always the longing for renewal, the search for liberation. My work is a dialogue with the unconscious and in this respect also a path to awareness. I explore my inner space of experience and intuitively create images that reflect inner processes, moods and feelings. We humans share this inner experiential space. We are connected through it. So my pictures can be both personal and universal at the same time. I also see my work as an opportunity for viewers to come into contact with their own vulnerability and fragility. I believe that there is beauty in our imperfection, transience and vulnerability. And I am convinced that if we allow ourselves to be touched by this, a deeper connection with life, with what surrounds us, is possible.

The streets still bear the names of Germanic deities.




